## This funding will be used to

- Improve the writing achievement of all students, Prep – 6 by building teacher capability to support and plan for the diverse needs in the classroom.
- Improve the writing achievement by enhancing teacher understanding and consistent implementation of high-yielding teaching strategies.
- Improve student A-E data across KLAs by concentrating on a rigorous curriculum, assessment and reporting cycle which include moderation at the school and cluster level.
- Improve SWD student data through knowing the student, knowing the curriculum, and know the next step by having access to human resources to deliver the needs of individual students.
- Support an upgrade for students to having access to 21<sup>st</sup> century ICT skills to support online NAPLAN.

## Our initiatives include

- Identifying and reviewing student learning goals for writing and reading based on the Literacy Continuum with students and parents.
- Continued development of all staff knowledge in the use of the Literacy Continuum to effectively support the delivery of the Australian Curriculum in writing and reading to formulate whole class, group and individual goals to support the next step in the teaching and learning cycle.
- Develop and implement a whole school approach to teaching writing – Millaa Millaa Writing framework based on the PD from 'Literacy Solutions'.
- Establish effective school processes, including establishing case management and professional development processes to support differentiation for student inclusion.
- Engage and monitor all school educators in effective teaching strategies as defined in the whole school Observation and Coaching model.
- Establish and engage in effective whole school processes, including whole school planning days and building capability days.
- Aligning human resources to the whole school, groups and individual needs in the school to support improvement in data.
- Aligning financial resources to the upgrade of ICT at Millaa Millaa SS so students have daily access to laptops so they are effective and efficient during NAPLAN online testing.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Provision of additional time TRS for Teachers to have whole school planning days / professional development.           | \$ 8 000 |
| • Provision of additional time for Teacher Aide to support the inclusion and needs of SWD students (groups, individual). | \$18 000 |
| • Purchase of Literacy resources to consolidate students learning across the KLAs.                                       | \$ 5 146 |
| • Provision of laptops/iPads to increase opportunities to interact with ICT.   | \$15 000 |
